Rites Conducted for Mrs. Juanita Blair, 23

Funeral services for Mrs. Juanita Blair, age twenty-three, of Brownstown, were conducted at 2 o'clock this afternoon from the home and at 2:30 o'clock from the Church of the Nazarene in Brownstown with the Rev. Paul Hoult, pastor, in charge. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Blair, a life-long resident of Brownstown, died Saturday night at the home following an illness of two years' duration.

A native of Brownstown, Mrs. Blair was born on December 24, 1922, the daughter of Sanford E. Blair and Cora E. Blair, Blevins. The father preceded her in death but the mother survives. She was married on April 15, 1939, at North Vernon to Edward W. Blair, who was killed in World War II.

Mrs. Blair was a member of the Brownstown Church of the Nazarene and made many friends who mourn her death.

Besides the mother, she is survived by a son, Jerry Jeanne Blair, at home; a brother, James Blevins, of Brownstown and a sister, Mrs. Faye Guellett, of Columbus.
