E. T. (Pete) Blankenship Succumbs—Funeral Rites Held Sunday Afternoon

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home here for Evan and Thomas (Pete) Blankenship, well known Ewing resident, who died Thursday night at the family residence there. He had been ill for seven weeks.

The Rev. Myron Hinton, pastor of the Brownstown Baptist Church, conducted the funeral rites and burial was in Fairview Cemetery.

Mr. Blankenship, who was a brick mason and plasterer, was born on May 30, 1878, near Seymour, the son of the late John and Caldonia Hudson Blankenship. He had spent practically all of his life in Brownstown, was a member of the Brownstown Baptist Church and was widely known throughout the entire county.

On August 5, 1916, he was married in Jackson county to Naomi Aufderheide, who survives as do a daughter, Mrs. Geraldine George, of Ewing, a step-son Ray Jarvis, of Muncie three grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, a sister, Mrs. Maybelle Payne, of Seymour, and several nieces and nephews.
