Funeral Rites Held for County People's Sister

Funeral services for Mrs. Bessie L. Bohall, 75, widow of William Bohall and sister of Richard Fordice, and Mrs. Mae McCrary, both of Brownstown, were conducted this afternoon from Wertz Memorial Evangelical United Brethren Church, Columbus, with Dr. J. R. Simmerman in charge. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Bohall died suddenly early Sunday morning at her home in Columbus. She had been in failing health for several years.

A daughter of the late John and Harriet Huckelberry Fordice, Mrs. Bohall was born in Jackson county August 30, 1881, and spent her early life here. She had resided in Columbus for the last 45 years and was a member of Wertz Memorial Evangelical United Brethren Church there.

On May 11, 1897, she was married to William Bohall, who preceded her in death on August 4, 1955. Two brothers, two sisters, and two grandchildren also preceded her in death.

Survivors include one son, seven daughters, the brother and two sisters. Sixteen grandchildren and six great-grandchildren also survive.
