William D. Bohall Dies —Ex-County Resident

William D. Bohall, 77, a former resident of Brownstown, died at 11:20 o'clock Thursday morning at his home, 1637 Orinoco avenue, Columbus. Death followed an illness of several years.

Funeral services will be conducted Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the residence in Columbus. Following the services there, the funeral party will go to Brownstown where graveside rites will be conducted at Fairview Cemetery. The casket will be opened at the grave.

Mr. Bohall, a former wood-carver with the Lincoln and Orinoco Chair Companies at Columbus and at one time a carpenter for the Columbus public schools, was the son of the late William and Anna Bohall. He was born and reared in the Brownstown vicinity. He and his wife, the former Bessie Fordyce, celebrated their golden wedding anniversary May 11, 1948. The Bohalls resided in Brownstown for a time before moving to Columbus 45 years ago. Mr. Bohall was a member of the Wertz Memorial Evangelical United Brethren Church.

Besides the widow, he is survived by eight children, Mrs. Garton Tillman and Ceibert Bohall, of Phoenix, Ariz., Mrs. Chester E. Livingston, of Knightstown, Mrs. Wallace McComas, of Peru, Mrs. Brown, Mrs. Donald Miller, and Mrs. Ruby Earhart, of Columbus, and Mrs. Mary Frances Brown, of Indianapolis.
