Mrs. Victor Boofer, 39, Dies—Rites Tuesday

Mrs. Nettie Boofer, 39, wife of Victor Boofer, died at 8 o'clock Saturday night at her home in Brownstown. She had been ill for the past three months with a complication of diseases.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home in Brownstown with Gene Dulin, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Boofer was a native of Hustonville, Ky., where she was born July 26, 1915, the daughter of Henry Clay and Vina Ellen Singleton Martin. The mother survives, living at Jacksonville, Ill.
