Robert B. Bowling, 84, Crothersville, died at 4:20 p.m. Saturday, April 29, 2006, at Brownstown.

Mr. Bowling was of the Baptist faith. He served in the U.S. Army in World War II and was a retired mechanic who had worked at Hamilton Motors, Brown Chevrolet and Bowling Garage. He was a member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Men's Auxiliary 6582, Moose Lodge of Scott County, American Legion Post 89, Seymour, and Fraternal Order of Eagles, Seymour.
