BROWNSTOWN — Charles R. Braden, 82, 423 Ashland, died at 1:30 p.m. Sunday at Hoosier Christian Village here. He had been ill six months.

He was the father of Wylda Beshar, Columbus. A member of Brownstown Christian Church, he retired from Cummins Engine Co., Columbus, after 32 years service.

Funeral service will be conducted by the Rev. Elvin Gray at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Spurgeon Funeral Home here where persons may call after 5 p.m. today. Burial will be at Fairview Cemetery.
