## C. A. BRANAMAN IS SUMMONED BY DEATH

Native of County Passes Away in Bedford—Funeral Rites Tuesday.

Christian A. Branaman, sixty-nine years old, Bedford druggist, and a native of Jackson county, died at 6 o'clock Sunday night at his home in Bedford, from a cerebral hemorrhage suffered at his home Friday evening. He had been in failing health for several years with heart trouble.

Mr. Branaman was born to Abraham and Julia (McDade) Branaman July 11, 1864.

He was united in marriage to Miss Effie Browning June 10, 1891, her death occurring some years later. He was married a second time May 23, 1897 to Miss Annie Applewhite. He had been in the drug business at Bedford for the past twenty-five years.

As was a member of the Presbyterian church and belonged to the Brownstown K. of P. Lodge.

He is survived by the widow, one son, Glenn Branaman, Ronceverte, W. Va.; a daughter, Mrs. Lois Litzler, at home; a half brother, Bruce Branaman, of Florida, and three grandchildren.

Funeral services were conducted at the Day and Carter Chapel in Bedford at 1 o'clock Tuesday afternoon in charge of the Rev. Harry T. Bridwell, pastor of the Clear Creek Christian Church. Burial in the Fairview cemetery at Brownstown.
