## FRANK BRANAMAN DIES AFTER SHORT ILLNESS

Little Son of Mr. And Mrs. John C.  
Branaman Victim of Attack of  
Acute Bright's Disease

Frank Branaman, Jr., little son of Mr. and Mrs. John C. Branaman of Brownstown, died this morning about 4 o'clock at the Branaman home after an illness of but a few days of acute Bright's disease.

He was taken ill last Friday while at school and was sent home by his teacher. Dr. J. D. Cummings, the family physician was called and on Sunday his condition had become so serious that Drs. Osterman, Graessle and Gillespie of this city were called in consultation, and a specialist from Louisville was also called. Extreme nervousness and delirium developed until it was necessary to hold the little patient in his bed.

Brownstown has not recorded a case of sickness in years which attracted more sympathy and interest. He was in his first year of school and was a bright and most loveable little boy with a host of friends. His school teacher, Miss Lena Boyatt, was at the Branaman home almost constantly after he went home from school ill, on Friday. Almost countless expressions of sympathy have been given his grief stricken parents. He was their only child.

The funeral will be held from the home at Brownstown Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery at Brownstown.
