Mrs. John C. "Mollie" Branaman, 87, of 420 W. Spring St., Brownstown, died early Friday morning, Dec. 15, at the Jackson County Hospital following a brief illness.

Mrs. Branaman was the widow of the late John C. Branaman, a former state representative and Jackson Circuit Court judge. A member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church, Mrs. Branaman was a patroness of Beta Mu Chapter, Psi Iota Xi sorority and was a charter member of the Brownstown Study Club. She was active in various PTA groups in past years and worked with the Girl Scout program.

Mrs. Branaman was born Jan. 24, 1891, in Brownstown, to the late Henry F. and Amolia Vonnotte Kopp. She married Judge Branaman in 1916, and he preceded her in death on Dec. 15, 1944.
