John L. Bridgewater, B'town Native, Dies— Burial Rites Here

John L. Bridgewater, 60, a native of Brownstown, died early this morning at the family home, 332 South Broadway in Seymour.

He was born in Brownstown on March 24, 1899, a son of T. J. Bridgewater and the late Nora Bridgewater.

On July 21, 1946, he was married at Bedford to Lora Elkins, who survives as do a daughter, Mrs. Betty Cottingham, of Kokomo; two brothers, Jesse Bridgewater, of near Freetown, and Howard Bridgewater, R1, Brownstown, and three grandchildren.

A laborer by occupation Mr. Bridgewater formerly was employed at the Seymour Manufacturing Company and also The National Veneer Company, in Seymour. He was a World War II veteran.

Funeral rites will be held at 2:00 o'clock Friday afternoon from the Voss Chapel, Seymour, in charge of the Rev. J. T. Moore, Central Christian pastor. Burial will be in Brownstown Fairview Cemetery.
