

Ewing Druggist Dies Suddenly

Charles Brock Suffers Heart Attack Tuesday Night—Funeral Thursday.

Charles Brock, age sixty-six, a druggist in Ewing for thirty years, died suddenly as a result of a heart attack at his home Tuesday night at 8 o'clock.
