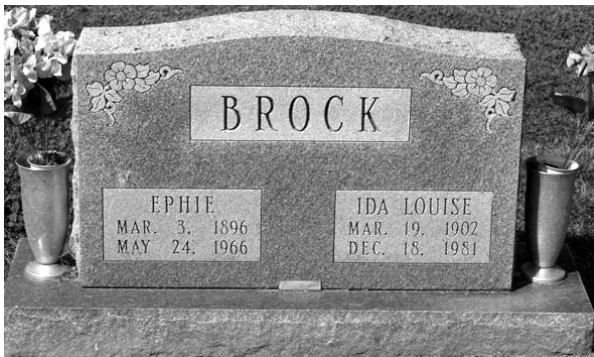

Medora Resident, 70, Expires At Hospital

Ephie Brock Sr., 70, Medora, died at 12:15 p. m. Tuesday at Schneck Memorial Hospital here. He had been admitted to the hospital for medical treatment Monday.

Mr. Brock was a retired farmer and a former employe of the Medora Brick Company. He also was a veteran of World War I.

He was born March 3, 1896, in Wise County, Va., to the late Daniel and Cindy Stallard Brock. He had moved to Jackson County about 25 years ago.

He was married Aug. 16, 1919, at Molus, Ky., to his wife, Ida, who survives.

Survivors besides the widow include four daughters, Mrs. Geneva Dean, Mrs. Selma Verble and Mrs. Jewel Beavers, all of Medora, and Mrs. Magdalene Foist, Seymour; four sons, Arvil, Edward, George and Ephie Brock Jr., all of Medora; two brothers, Henderson Brock, Molus, Ky., and William Brock, Seadrift, Tex.; four sisters, Mrs. Cassie Russell, Salem, Ind., Mrs. Nettie Saylor, Molus, Ky., Mrs. Emma Saylor and Mrs. Bell Cornett, both of Harlan, Ky.; and 25 grandchildren.
