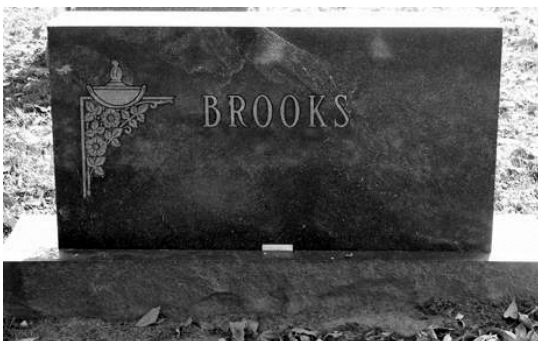
She was preceded in death by two sisters and one brother.
