Brough—Mrs Edith Brough passed away at her home in Brownstown Thursday night, October 19, at 10 o'clock, of tuberculosis, aged 48 years, 2 months and 16 days.

Deceased was the eldest daughter of Alex and Anna Dougherty and was born at Vallonia August 5, 1874. After her graduation from the Vallonia high school in 1892, she moved to Brownstown with her parents, where she resided until her death. She was united in marriage to Oscar Brough Feb. 26, 1899. To this union were born two daughters, Mildred and Doris, who survive her. Her husband preceded her to the grave

October 21, 1921. She also leaves her mother, one sister, Mrs. Delphia Smallwood, of Brownstown and six brothers, Tom, Edgar and Chesley Dougherty of Brownstown, John Dougherty, of Seymour; Henry Dougherty of South Dakota, and Edward Dougherty of Oregon. She had been in poor health for four years, but during that time she bore her suffering patiently and was always cheerful.

Funeral services were conducted at her late home Saturday morning at 10 o'clock, Rev. F. M. Moore of the Presbyterian church, officiating. Burial at Fairview cemetery.
