Mrs. E. B. Browning Dies Near Brownstown

Mrs. Elizabeth Buanna "Buna" Browning, 77, a resident of Brownstown township virtually all her life, died late Sunday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Ora Hunsucker, Brownstown R1 in the Pleasant Grove neighborhood north of Brownstown. She had been in failing health for the past year and seriously ill for the last four years.

Mrs. Browning was born August 12, 1875, in Indiana, the daughter of the late Ephriam and Nettie Gayhart Thompson. She was married February 11, 1891, in Salt Creek township to John R. Browning, who died September 23, 1944. She was a member of the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church and enjoyed the acquaintance and esteem of a host of friends who mourn her death.

She is survived by nine children: Mrs. Ora Hunsucker, Brownstown R1, at whose home she died; Mrs. Raymond Dailey, of Indianapolis; Mrs. Rolland Jolly, Cortland R1; Mrs. Luther Conner, of Tampa, Fla.; Ralph and Charles Browning, both of Brownstown R1; William Browning, Cortland R1; Leonard Browning, Seymour R4 and Otis Browning, Brownstown R1. Three sons preceded her in death. Also surviving are a half-brother, Jason Thompson, and two half-sisters, Mrs. Ruby Willis and Mrs. Luella Lubbers, all of Missouri; 19 grandchildren and 12 great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon from the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church with the Rev. E. L. Cobbs, pastor, and the Rev. Russell Knudson, pastor of the Church of the Nazarene in Free-town, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
