## Ralph Browning

Ralph Browning, 79, of 1016 East Fourth Street Road, died at 1:50 p. m. Thursday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital following an illness of three months.

A native of this county, Mr. Browning was a retired employee of Seymour Manufacturing Co.

Born April 18, 1899, in Jackson County, he was the son of the late John R. and Buna Thompson Browning.
