Buening — Mrs. Rozella Rucker Buening passed away at the Madison hospital Friday, May 1.

The body was brought here to the Wallace Funeral Home, where services in charge of the Rev. J. O. Reynolds were conducted on her 61st birthday anniversary, Sunday afternoon, May 3rd, at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Mrs. Buening was born near Tampico and was the daughter of Shiveral and Harriett Rucker, deceased. She spent her girlhood days there and united with the Christian church under the pastorate of Elder Thomas Jones and received most of her education in the Tampico schools.
