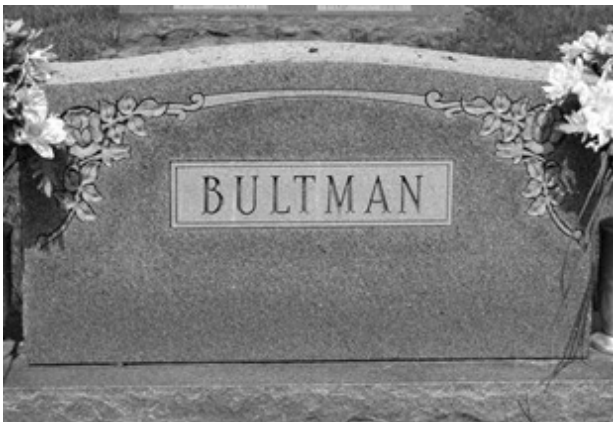

Herbert Bultman, Lifelong County Resident, Dies

Herbert E. Bultman, 67, Brownstown mechanic, died at 12:45 p. m. Tuesday at Winona Memorial Hospital, Indianapolis. He had been ill for three days following an accident in which he fell from a tree in the yard in his home, 115 West Spring street, Brownstown.

A lifelong resident of the county, he had been employed for the past 15 years as a mechanic for B & T Sales and Services (formerly Scott's Implements) of Brownstown.

He was a member of the Brownstown United Methodist Church.

Born Nov. 6, 1901 at Honeytown, he was the son of the late Charles and Ada Sewell Bultman. On Nov. 2, 1928, in Brownstown, he married the former Avis Oathout, who survives.

In addition to the widow, he is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Alfred (Patricia) Forgey, of Brownstown; one son, Herbert Bultman, Jr., of Indianapolis; one sister, Mrs. Hazel Hiten, of Seymour; and five grandchildren.
