DEATH RECORD.

MRS. AMANDA CRABB, whose serious illness was mentioned last week, died Monday evening, July 22nd, 1901, of dysentery, aged 57 years, 1 month and 13 days. The funeral services were held at the M. E. church this morning, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

Miss Amanda Lawell was born in Brownstown, June 9. 1844, and was the daughter of Oscar F. Lawell, Sr., and wife, both deceased. She was united in marriage to Marion Crabb in November, 1867. To their union were born twin babies, both dying in infancy. Her husband preceded her to the grave in November 1869, after which she again made her home with her parents until their death about a year ago, since which time she kept house for her brothers.

Deceased was a true christian lady, having been a consistent member of the M. E. church since 1859. She was a kind and industrious woman and highly respected by the entire community.

One sister, Mrs. M. N. Findley, of Cortland, and two brothers, John and Oscar, of this place, survive her. The latter has several small children to whom Mrs. Crabb has given a mother's attention since the death of their own mother about a year ago.

This family seems to have more than its share of sadness, this being the fourth death that has occurred in the family within little more than a year, and the bereaved relatives have the heartfelt sympathy of our citizens in general.
