

Cribb Funeral Rites Are Held

Funeral services were conducted at 2 o'clock this afternoon from the home in Brownstown for Robert Henry "Harry" Cribb, well known Brownstown resident. The Rev. O. S. Brooke and the Rev. E. E. Pedicord were in charge. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.

Mr. Cribb, a painter and paper hanger, died at 10 o'clock Saturday morning at the home following an illness with which he had suffered during the greater part of the winter. He was seventynine years of age.
