

AGED LADY ANSWERS DEATH'S SUMMONS

Mrs. Susan Endebrock Succumbs to Cancer—Two Former Citizens Brought Here for Burial.

List Of Deaths Not Reported In The Items From Our Regular Correspondents.

ENDEBROCK-Mrs. Susan Endebrock, one of Brownstown's most highly esteemed ladies, died at her home at this place Thursday night, April 6, 1916, of cancer, aged 76 years and 6 months.

Deceased was a daughter of John DeWyke, a sea captain, who came to this country from Hollard, and she was the oldest of a family of ten children all of whom had preceded her to the grave. She was born near Saures October 6, 1839, and was united in marriage to Henry Endebrock in 1861 and settled at Tampico, where the family lived until 1910, when they moved to Brownstown. To their union were born six children, four boys and two girls, of whom one son, Albert, who lived with his mother, and one daughter, Mrs. Lou Balsley of this place survive her. She also leaves one granddaughter, Miss Louise Endebrock, of Clarinda, Iowa. Her husband preceded her to the grave July 22, 1900.

Deceased was a woman of many excellent traits of charcter, a kind neighbor, a sympathizing friend and was greatly devoted to her family. She was a member of the Presbytertian church having united with the old Presbyterian church at Euchretown, now Wegan, in early life and remained a consistent member thereof until death.

The funeral services were conducted at the Presbyterian church Monday morning at 10 o'clock Rev. W. U. Guerrant officiating after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
