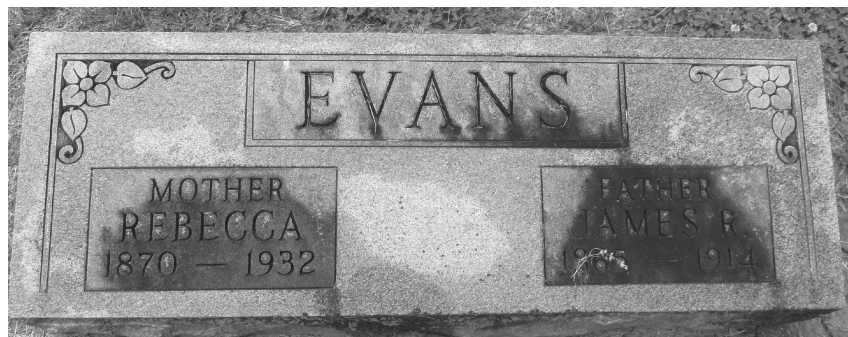

EVANS—James Robert Evans, whose sickness was mentioned in this paper a few weeks ago, died at his home in Bedford Friday, August 28, 1914. He had been in poor health for some time. Several months ago he suffered a stroke of paralysis and this complicated with asthma and heart trouble was the cause of his death.

Deceased was born in Washington county April 2, 1865, making his age at the time of death, 49 years, 4 months and 26 days. He was united in marriage to Rebecca Trueblood April 28, 1889, and to their union were born ten children of whom eight—Hugh, Clyde, Mrs. Ruth Finley, Marshall, Allen, Floyd, Ward and Robert Edward together with their mother are left to mourn his death.

He united with the Christian church at Tampico at the age of 12 years, and remained a member thereof until 1906 when he united with the Christian church at this place. The family moved to Brownstown about 1901 and left here about 1908, and after a residence of several other places they moved to Bedford about two years ago. He was a devoted husband and father and will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

The remains were brought here Saturday evening and taken to the home of his sister-in-law, Mrs. Vincent Tidwell. The funeral services, conducted by Rev. G. M. Shotts, of Seymour, assisted by Rev. T. J. Due, were held at the Christian church Sunday afternoon at two o'clock followed by interment in Fairview cemetery.
