Miss Ann Findley died at the home of Abel McCormick, last Thursday, March 13, 1890, after a short illness, aged 78 years, 8 months, and 23 days. The funeral took place three days later at the home of Abel McCormick, with whom the deceased had made her home for the last thirty-five years. A large concourse of people were in attendance. Rev. W. N. Fletcher of the M. E. Church, preached the funeral discourse. The deceased was born in Flemming county, Ky., July 7, 1811, and was with her parents among the pioneer settlers of Jackson county. She had been a resident of this county ever since. At an early age she united herself with the Presbyterian church. But it is, however, useless for us to speak of her inestimable character to those who knew her. In brief, she was a plain, unassuming child of God. Thus has closed the life of a good and true woman.
