Rites Here Thursday For Miss Bess Findley— Brownstown Native

Funeral rites will be held at 1 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home here for Miss Bess Findley, native of Brownstown, who was found dead by her sister, Miss Grace Findley, at their home in Colorado Springs, Colorado, last Sunday morning.

Six years ago, following the death of her brother, Harry Findley, of Seymour, for whom she had cared for several years, Miss Findley went to live with her sister.

Born about one-half mile east of Brownstown, Miss Findley was one of twelve children of the late William and Sarah Durland Findley. She was educated in Brownstown schools and was graduated with the Class of 1902 from Brownstown High School. She decided to make nursing her career and entered the Cook County Hospital, Chicago, from which she was graduated and received her R. N. certificate.

She followed the nursing profession for many years and at one time was a member of the nursing staff at the Jackson county hospital. She was a member of the Methodist Church.

The sister in Colorado Springs is her only near surviving relative. Seven brothers and three sisters are deceased.

The funeral party will arrive about 8 o'clock tonight and friends may call at the Winklepleck Funeral Home from 9 o'clock Thursday morning until the hour of the funeral.

The rites will be in charge of the Rev. Wayland E. Siders, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church. Interment will be in Fairview Cemetery.
