The death of Geo. Edward Fislar residing one mile east of town, occurred last Thursday. He was sick but a few days. Blood poison was the result of a large carbuncle on his head. He was united in marriage to Miss Anna Loudon of Brownstown, who with two children survive him, two having preceded him to the grave. The deceased was thirty two years of age. The funeral services were conducted at his late home Saturday at 10 o'clock by Rev. E. L. Sanders, of Brownstown, after which a large cortege followed the remains to Fairview cemetery at Brownstown. The deceased was a good citizen liked by all who knew him. He was born April 4th, 1866, and was 32 years, 1 month and 28 days old. He was a member of the German Presbyterian Church.
