Ewell S. Ford was born at Charlestown, Indiana, April 9, 1820, and died at his home in Brownstown on Friday afternoon, June 27, 1890, at 5:40 o'clock, aged 70 years, 2 months and 18 days.

Mr. Ford resided at Charlestown until he was 24 years of age, when he removed to Brownstown, where he has resided permanently ever since. In August, 1846, when 26 years of age, he was united in marriage to Miss Lucy Phillips, who still survives him. By this happy union no children were born. During the 46 years that Mr. Ford resided in Brownstown he spent 22 years as Superintendent of the Poor Farm, which position was only released on account of poor health. His life may truly be said to have been lived for others. Whether in his home or in society he was the same unselfish creature, willing in the discharge of every duty, always being more kind and considerate to others than himself. He was a very popular and prominent citizen in Brownstown. Our hearts are sore for the widow who has been deprived of a kind and loving husband, and to her we extend our sympathy, trusting that "God will be a husband to the widow."
