### Mrs. Elsie Gray, 68, B'town, Dies Today

Mrs. Elsie A. Gray, 68, Brownstown, died at 5:30 a. m. today at Robert Long Hospital, Indianapolis, following an illness of three years. She had been seriously ill for the past four months.
