Hancock—Mrs. Susan E. Hancock, age 85, one of Brownstown's oldest and highly esteemed residents, passed away at her home Monday morning at 9:30 o'clock following an illness of ten days. Death was due to general infirmities.

Funeral services, conducted by the Rev. Clyde Black, pastor of the Methodist church, were held at the residence this morning at 10 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Mrs. Hancock was born in Brown county, Indiana, February 15, 1853, the daughter of Joseph E. and Almira McKinney Spurgeon, and was the last surviving member of the family. On September 2, 1871, she was married at Salem to William T. Hancock, who preceded her in death eighteen years ago. She was a member of the Brownstown Methodist church. She was a good, kind neighbor and had many friends.

She is survived by three sons, Frank and Charley Hancock, both at home, and Alva Hancock, of Brownstown; two grandchildren, Mrs. Walter Hiatt, of Seymour, and Doren Hancock, of Brownstown, whom she had reared as her own, and one great-grandchild.
