Heller—Miss Rosa Heller, who had been sick for some time, passed away at the hospital at Madison Saturday morning, aged 78 years, 1 month and 8 days.

Miss Heller was one of ten children born to Adam and Wilhelmina Schwein Heller and was born on the Heller homestead two and a half miles southeast of Brownstown, August 14, 1850, and with the exception of a few years spent in California, she spent her entire life in Jackson county. In early girlhood she united with the Brownstown Presbyterian church and remained a member until death. On account of ill health she had been unable to attend church for several years.

The body was brought to the home of her brother, Peter Heller, Saturday afternoon. Funeral services were held at the Presbyterian church Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Roy Brumbaugh officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
