

Sherman W. Jackson Dies At Age Of 88 Years

Death came suddenly at noon last Saturday to eighty-eightyear-old Sherman W. Jackson, native and life-long resident of this community, who for many years was one of the county's prominent farmers.

Mr. Jackson died at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Stilwell, R1. Freetown, with whom he had lived since the death of Mrs. Jackson in 1944.

Funeral rites were held at 1:30 o'clock Monday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home here, in charge of the Rev. Edgar Walls, pastor of the Free-town Evangelical United Proth

town Evangelical United Brethren Church, followed by burial in Fairview Cemetery.

A son of the late Henry and Mary Packwood Jackson, the deceased was born August 4, 1865, at the old Jackson homeplace located near Jackson Hill on State Road 135 and had spent all of his long life in that community. On August 4, 1886, he was married to Rose Allen, who died ten years ago.

Mr. Jackson was the father of two sons, Clifford R. Jackson, of Indianapolis, for many years a prominent business executive and civic leader in Seymour, and Ray C. Jackson, also of Indianapolis. Five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren also survive.
