John R. Jarvis Expires at 88

John R. Jarvis, a life-long resident of Jackson county, died at his home in Seymour Monday night at 10:45 o'clock, aged 88 years. He had been ill about three weeks.

He was born near Brownstown July 26, 1850. He was a son of William and Mary Banks Jarvis. He was united in marriage January 26, 1887, to Lillie Jenkins, who survives him together with three children, William Jarvis of Franklin; Mrs. William Amos and Mrs. Claude Connell, both of Seymour.
