Mrs. Lillie Kinney, 84, Dies—Funeral Friday

Mrs. Lillie Kinney, 84, who resided at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Irene Riordan, 203 East Laurel street, for several years, died at 8:15 a. m. today at the home of another daughter, Mrs. William Amos, 114½ South Chestnut street, where she was visiting. She had been ill for the past two weeks.

Mrs. Kinney was a life-long resident of Jackson county. She was born July 3, 1872, in this county, the daughter of the late Enoch and Ann Allery Jenkins. She spent her entire life in this county and was married in 1888 to John H. R. Jarvis, who died. They were the parents of six children. She later was married to William Kinney, who preceded her in death in 1937.

During her long residence in Jackson county, she made many friends who mourn her death.

She is survived by three children: William C. Jarvis, Mrs. William Amos and Mrs. Irene Riordan, all of Seymour; 14 grandchildren and 29 great grandchildren.
