JOHNSON—Mrs. Sarah Lefevre Johnson, whose serious illness was mentioned last week died at the Deaconess hospital in Indianapolis Thursday, June 21, following an operation for cancer of the liver, aged 60 years, 9 months and 21 days.

Sarah Owens was born at Pleasant Ridge, Jackson county, Indiana, September 3, 1856. In 1871 she united with the Christian church and remained a member there until death. On September 23, 1874, she was united in marriage to John W. Lefevre, who preceded her to the grave December 28, 1900. She was again united in marriage November 17, 1907, to R. M. Johnson, of Clermont, Ind., who survives her. Besides her husband she leaves three step-children, two brothers, McHenry Owen, of Bedford, Cass Owen, of Red Oak, South Dakota, and two sisters, Mrs. Hettie Henderson, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Laura Milligan, of Fayetteville, Ark. The remains were brought here Friday and taken to the home of her sister, Mrs. Henderson.

The funeral services were conducted at the Methodist church Friday morning at 10 o'clock by Rev. C. H. Pinnick, assisted by Rev. W. U. Guerant, pastor of the Presbyterian church after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
