Death of J. B. Kerner Aged 86

Well Known Jackson Co. Farmer Dies at Ratcliff Grove---Other Deaths Past Week.

John B. Kerner, age 86 years, 8 months and 22 days, a well-known Jackson county citizen, passed away at his home at Ratcliff Grove Brownstown township, Tuesday morning at seven o'clock. He had been in failing health for about a year but had only been confined to his bed about a month.

He was born in Baden, Germany, January 5, 1846. His parents came to this country when he was three years of age and settled in Pennsylvania. When he was seventeen years old he came to Indiana and spent the remainder of his life here.
