Amos Kinworthy, B'town Native, Dies At Seymour

Funeral rites were held this afternoon from the Chapel of the Burkholder Funeral Home, in Seymour, with burial in Fairview Cemetery, here, for Amos Kinworthy, a native of Brownstown.

In failing health for some time and seriously ill the past fortnight, Mr. Kinworthy, who was 67 years old, died at his home on South Broadway, in Seymour, early Monday morning.

He was born September 29, 1898, a son of the late Ison and Mattie Smith Kinworthy, and was married, in Brownstown, on July 22, 1939, to Violet Brooks.

He was a World War I veteran and a retired factory worker.

Surviving are a sister, Mrs. Kathryn Garramone, of Kansas City, Kansas, and two uncles, Dan Kinworthy and Ralph Kinworthy, both of Brownstown, and several nieces and nephews.
