Miss Minnie Klewitz, 82, a life-long and well known resident of Jackson county, died early Friday afternoon at Schneck Memorial Hospital. She had been in failing health for three years and had been seriously ill for the past 10 days.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. C. W. Taylor, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Miss Klewitz was born June 1, 1871, in the Pleasant Grove neighborhood in Jackson county, the daughter of the late Louis and Katherine Garis Klewitz.
