LAHRMAN — Henry Lahrman, well known and respected throughout Jackson county, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Emma Buening, at this place, Friday morning, November 10, 1916, of pneumonia, aged 64 years, 3 months and one day.

His death came as a shock to his relatives and friends. He was taken sick Tuesday and passed away Thursday morning at 2:35 o'clock. Deceased was born at Cincinnati, Ohio, August 9, 1852, and came to Jackson county with his parents in early childhood, locating at Wegan, where he resided until he was 19 years of age when the family moved to Brownstown township. He was united in marriage to Rachael Weddell August 14, 1873, and to their union were born seven children, of whom five survive him, viz: Edward, of Carlisle, Wash., Albert, who lives on the old homestead; George L., of Seymour; Mrs. Emma Buening, of Brownstown, and Henry M., of Elwood. He also leaves one brother, Frank Lahrman, of Vallonia, and one sister, Mrs. Lizzie Spray, of Pleasant Grove. His wife preceded him to the grave March 3, 1909.

The funeral services, which were largely attended, were held at his late home Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. Otto Schumm, pastor of the Lutheran church, officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
