Death passed through our village again Wednesday night, January 25, 1893, and summoned to its eternal abiding place the soul of our former fellow citizen and business man, Daniel H. Long. Several months ago its messenger proclaimed its coming, and for nearly two years deceased had been slowly declining. For three weeks past the spirit had been fluttering between life and death, expecting every hour the golden chord would be severed. To him death was, no doubt, a relief. His sufferings were terrible.

Services were held at the residence of Mrs. Sarah A. Long, in Brownstown, Saturday, January 28th, at one o'clock, Rev. W. N. Fletcher officiating. The remains were interred in Brownstown Cemetery.

DANIEL HORATIO LONG

Was born in Brownstown, Ind., April 15th, 1851; died January 25th, 1893, aged 41 years, 9 months and 11 days. He was a son of Hon. Daniel H. Long and Mrs. Sarah A. Long. He was reared in Brownstown, and received his earlier education in the Brownstown schools. He practiced law at Brownstown with his brother Byford E. Long till 1885, after which he filled the office of Prosecuting Attorney, to which he had been elected for four years. After retiring from the duties of his office he again resumed the practice of law at Seymour, but on account of Bright's disease he has been an invalid for the last three years of his life.
