MRS. MARGARET LOUDEN DIES AT BROWNSTOWN

Services will Be Conducted at
Brownstown Friday
Afternoon.

Funeral services for Mrs. Margaret I. Louden, age eighty-five, of Brownstown, will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Wallace Funeral Home in Brownstown, with the Rev. Clyde S. Black, pastor of the Trinity Methodist Church in Seymour, and the Rev. Frank Templin, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.

In failing health for the past five years, she died at the home at 6:30 o'clock Wednesday night.

She had lived in this county all her life and was born on February 4, 1856, the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Samuel Wilson. On September 16, 1875,

she was married to Jacob Louden, who died in 1911. Three children also preceded her in death.

The last of a family of nine children, she was widely known and well-liked. She was a member of the Methodist church.

Surviving are five children: Guy Louden and Mrs. Maude Lane, both of Brownstown, Mrs. May Stout, Mrs. Catherine Graham, and Walter Louden, all of Indianapolis, and one step-daughter, Mrs. Mollie Groover, of Elwood, Ind.
