WEEKLY DEATH RECORD

Lubker—William Lubker, whose serious illness has been mentioned, passed away at his home about one mile south of Brownstown, Monday night at 10:30 o'clock aged 78 years, 5 months and 3 days.

Mr. Lubker was born in Cincinnati December 29, 1851, and was the son of Henry and Catherine (Dinkelman) Lubker, deceased. When a small boy he moved to Grassy Fork township with his parents, where he resided until about fifty years ago when he moved to Brownstown and engaged in the hardware business with his brother, David H. Lubker, deceased. He continued in this business several years and then moved to Mooney Crossing, where he engaged in farming, later moving to his home south of Brownstown.

On December 28, 1880, he was married to Miss Carrie Vehslage, who preceded him in death August 28, 1899. To their union were born ten children of whom the following survive, William and Miss Dora Lubker, at home; Orville Lubker and Mrs. Lucy Gossman, of Brownstown; Mrs. Ethel Wagner and Miss Fredia Lubker of Chicago; sixteen grandchildren and

two half-brothers, Ulysses and Martin Lubker of Brownstown township.

Funeral services in charge of the Rev. Roy Bumbaugh, were held at the Presbyterian church this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
