DEATH RECORD.

MRS. MARY MARQUART, wife of Matthias Marquart, residing about a mile southeast of town, died Sunday, July 3, 1904, aged 67 years, 3-months and 16 days. She had been seriously sick for several months past of Brights disease, but her death was hastened, no doubt, by breaking her leg, mention of which was made in last week's issue. As the interior of the Presbyterian church is torn up on account of improvements that are being made, the funeral services were conducted at the Baptist church, Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. J. H. Weaver, pastor of the Presbyterian church officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

Deceased was a life long resident of Jackson county, being born at Vallonia, Ind., March 17, 1837. She was united in marriage to Matthias Marquart, February 13, 1855. To their union were born five children, four of whom are still living, viz: Mrs. Adda Gossman, Mrs. Margaret Stotz, Mrs. Carrie Bultman and Mrs. Anna Griffin, and who, with their aged father, are left to mourn the loss of a dear companion and mother. She was a consistent member of the Presbyterian church. She bore her sufferings with christian fortitude and was patiently waiting for the summons of her Master. She was a loving companion and a kind and affectionate mother and always ready to help the needy. She leaves a host of relatives and friends, who deeply sympathize with the grief stricken family in their hour of sorrow.
