Elgin McConnell, Barber, Justice Of Peace, Dies

Elgin G. McConnell, 65, of 611 East Fourth street, Seymour justice of the peace and a barber, died at 10 p. m. Monday in Silver Crest Hospital, New Albany. He had been in failing health for several years.

Mr. McConnell was reelected justice of the peace in 1958 after having served part of another term upon being appointed by the Jackson County board of commissioners.

He operated his barber shop and magistrate's office at 417 East Tipton street.

A native and life-long resident of Seymour, he was born February 28, 1896, son of the late Ira E. and Addie Jones McConnell.

Mr. McConnell was a veteran of World War I and had been active in Democratic politics for many years. He was a member of Seymour American Legion Post No. 89 and Seymour Aerie No. 655, Fraternal Order of Eagles.

Surviving is his sister-in-law, Mrs. Bonnie McConnell.

Mr. McConnell was preceded in death by two brothers and a sister.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p. m. Thursday from the Voss Chapel with the Rev. Ralph Adkins, pastor of the Seymour Evangelical United Brethren Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
