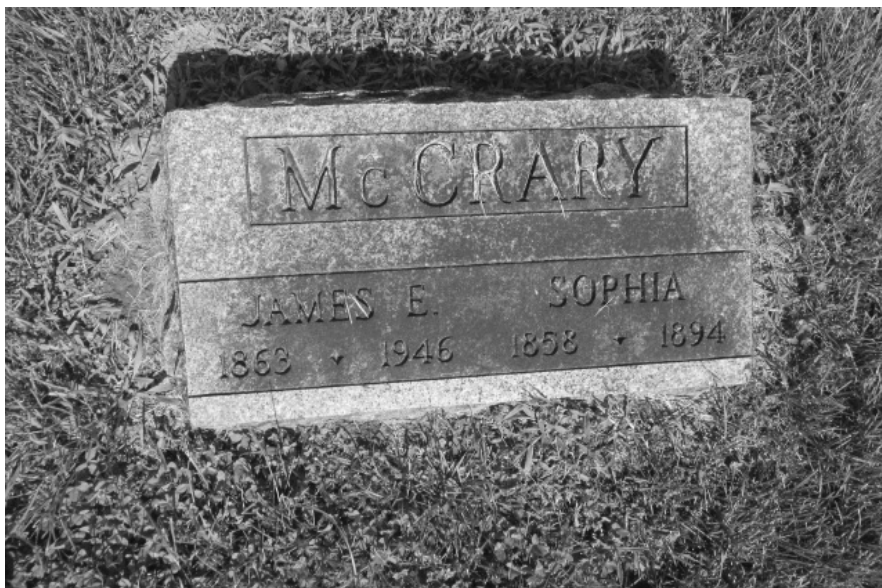

James Elba McCrary Dies at Brownstown

Funeral services for James Elba McCrary, age eighty-three, of Brownstown, who died Wednesday afternoon at Schneck Memorial Hospital, will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Central Standard Time, from the Winklepleck Funeral Home at Brownstown with the Rev. John U. Phelps, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

Mr. McCrary had been ill since January, and had been receiving treatment at the hospital for one week. He was a farmer and a former lumber dealer, and had spent all his life in and near Brownstown.

He was born February 21, 1863, at Brownstown, the son of James Elba and Susan Miller McCrary, who preceded him in death, and had been married three times.

He was first married to Sophie Rucker in Brownstown, and after her death he was married in Brownstown to Mary Kenworthy. After the death of his second wife he was married in Brownstown to Alice Wineinger, who survives.

Other survivors include one son from the first marriage, William McCrary of Brownstown; two children from the second marriage, George Elba McCrary of Griffith, Ind., and John Raymond McCrary of Criesco, Mich., and one step-daughter of the third marriage, Mrs. Alice Russell, a nurse at the Veterans' Hospital at Indianapolis.
