## MRS. M'KAIN IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Mother of the Late Dr. M.  
C. McKain Dies in Sey-  
mour Hospital.

Mrs. Anna Blanche McKain, 82, of Brownstown, mother of the late Dr. Maurice C. McKain of Columbus, died Wednesday in Schneck Memorial hospital at Seymour, three weeks after she suffered a broken hip in a fall.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon in the Methodist church at Brownstown, with the Rev. Russell Hall, pastor, in charge. Burial will be made in Fairview cemetery at Brownstown.

Mrs. McKain's survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Ida Lee Lucas of Brownstown, eight grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren. The son, Dr. M. C. McKain, prominent Columbus surgeon, was killed in a traffic accident here nine years ago.

Mrs. McKain was widely known in Jackson county and had taught in the old Normal school at Ewing. She also had served as a deputy postmistress. A native of Brownstown, she was married to David M. McKain in 1891. Her parents were the late James and Hannah Ogden Allen.

The casket is open at the Winklepeck Funeral home in Brownstown.
