McNiece—Richard J. McNiece died at his home in Brownstown township, about a mile southeast of Surprise, Monday night, June 3, 1912, of paralysis, aged 58 years and two months. Last Friday while harrowing in a field near his home he was stricken with paralysis. His condition was critical from the start and he never regained consciousness.

Deceased was a well-known farmer of this township. He was born in Jefferson county, but spent most of his life in this county. He is survived by three brothers and two sisters, viz: John, William and Mrs. Ezra Whitcomb, of this township; George, of Seymour, and Mrs. Emma Lawler, of Kansas.
