Former B'town Dentist Expires

Dr. Joseph S. McNinch, 77, of Chicago, a former Brownstown dentist, died at 3:35 a. m. Friday in St. Luke's-Presbyterian Hospital there. He had been ill for 10 weeks.

Born August 17, 1881, in LaPorte, Ind., Dr. McNinch was the son of the late James S. and Lydia Hammond McNinch. He married the late Genevieve Robertson McNinch on April 4, 1905, at Brownstown. Mrs. McNinch died in 1956.

A dentist in Brownstown for several years, Dr. McNinch was a veteran of World War I.

Surviving are three sisters-in-law, Mrs. S. W. McNinch, Marble Rock, Ia.; Mrs. George W. Gunder, Brownstown; and Mrs. Carrie R. Mather, Los Angeles, Calif.

Dr. McNinch was preceded in death by a son and brother.
