PEARL MILLER.

Miss Pearl Miller, daughter of E. W. Miller, died at the family residence, June 22nd, 1899, of cerebro spinal meningitis. She had been in poor health for two years, but was only stricken with the malady, which ended her young life, about four weeks ago.

Miss Pearl was born Sept. 20th, 1877, consequently was 21 years, 9 months and 2 days old at the time of her death. Though young in years, by her noble traits of character, she had ingratiated herself with a large circle of admiring friends. From her infancy she was affiliated with the Christian church to which she ever proved a pious and devout member. She bore her suffering with Christian fortitude, and realizing the approaching end, she made known that she was ready, requesting that P. M. Kendall, of Columbus, who baptised her, preach her funeral.

The funeral occurred at the Christian church Friday morning, after which the remains were interred in Fairview cemetery.
