Death of Mrs. S. R. Moore.

It is with sorrow we announce the death of Mrs. Elizabeth B. Moore, wife of Sylvester R. Moore, who breathed her last on Tuesday morning, August 9th, at 3 o'clock. Some four weeks ago she was violently seized with enteric catarrhal fever, superinducing hemorrhage, which baffled the skill of her physician, and finally terminated in her death, as above stated. She was a most exemplary lady and a devout christian. When about 20 years of age she connected herself with the Christian Church at Cincinnati, Ohio, and lived the life of a true christian ever h afterward. As a wife and mother, she was all love and devotion, and ever had words of comfort and encouragement to cheer her husband and children. By her death they have sustained an irreparable loss.

Mrs. Moore was a daughter of Hiram and Eliza Moore of Greenville, in Floyd county. Her age was 28 years, 8 months and 1 day. She was united in marriage to Sylvester R. Moore November 2d, 1875, and shortly after came to this county. She leaves her husband and two children, a father, four brothers and one sister.

The funeral took place yesterday morning. The remains were taken to the Baptist Church, where an affecting discourse was delivered by Elder Washington Hogg, after which they were conveyed to the new cemetery and lain away to rest with the rites of the Order of the Daughters of Rebekah, of which she was a member.
