Death of Mrs. Nancy Moreland.

Mrs. Nancy Moreland, mother of Misses Jennie and Kate Moreland of Brownstown and Oliver Moreland of Ewing, passed calmly and peacefully to the spirit world at 25 minutes past 11 o'clock on Monday morning, after long confinement to house and bed, a sufferer from that dread disease, consumption. Her age was 70 years and 8 months. Her maiden name was Nancy Ferris, and she was born in Shelby County, Kentucky. In early life she was joined in marriage to William Moreland, by whom she had ten children—five boys and five girls—six of whom are living. Her husband died about 35 years ago, leaving the large family of children dependent upon her exertions for maintenance. Mrs. Moreland came to Indiana in March, 1865, and during the past twenty years resided in this place. She was a woman of the most exalted qualities of head and heart, and by her kindness and amiability endeared herself in the affections of all who enjoyed her acquaintance. She was a true christian, and for 30 years was a faithful and devoted member of the M. E. Church. Her funeral took place this (Wednesday) afternoon, with services at the residence conducted by Rev. George Cochran, after which the remains were laid to rest in the new cemetery.
